


Retail Customers Purchasing Green-e Energy by Product Type, 1998-2011

Total Certified Transactions: 39 Million MWh


21% growth in retail sales from 2010

37% growth in non-residential sales






- 50 organizations and over 500 products participated in Green-e Marketplace.
- First use of Green-e Marketplace for electric vehicle charging stations: Austin Energy's Plug-In EVerywhere network.
- Re:print program expanded to printers in 7 states.
- Certified sales grew by nearly 9% from 2010 sales to over 220,000 metric tons carbon-dioxide-equivalent.
- Offsets sourced from wind electricity generation, mine-mouth methane capture and reutilization, solar, biomass, sustainable hydro, geothermal power generation, and methane capture from landfills.
- Offset projects in the U.S., China, Turkey, and Brazil.




Green-e Climate Certified Offsets
