

# Green-e® Energy Certification Application

## Renewable Community Option Overview

Entergy Mississippi, LLC is pursuing Green-e® Energy Certification for Renewable Community Option (RCO). Renewable Community Option is a voluntary tariff that provides commercial and industrial customers with the opportunity to access renewable resources. It is available to commercial and industrial customers only. The total amount of capacity currently available under RCO is 40 MW and customers may subscribe up to 5,000 kW, provided there is capacity available. As a subscriber to the tariff, a customer will pay a monthly subscription fee in exchange for the renewable energy credits (RECs) associated with their subscription. These credits will be retired by Entergy Mississippi on behalf of the subscribing customer. Renewable Community Option has one option that requires a 1 one-year contractual commitment that is on an auto-renewable subscription. As a subscriber to the tariff, you will pay a monthly subscription fee (Fixed monthly subscription cost of \$7.00 per kW) in exchange for a variable credit based on the output of the renewable resource that may be impacted by weather and availability. All customers who subscribe can receive customer specific emissions reporting. The Renewable Community Option enrollment level is meeting the *Green-e® Renewable Energy Standard for Canada and the United States*.

At this time, Entergy Mississippi, LLC is seeking certification for Renewable Community Option which meets the requirements outlined in the *Green-e® Renewable Energy Standard for Canada and the United States* (the “Standard”) and the *Green-e® Energy Code of Conduct for Canada and the United States*, as highlighted below.

- **New Renewables:** Resources that are allocated to the program or procured will meet the requirement for beginning operation or having been repowered according to the “New Date” as listed in the Standard.
- **Renewable Energy Credit (REC) Tracking:** The RECs generated from facility meeting the requirement set forth in the Standard will be tracked in NAR North American Renewable Registry. Entergy Mississippi will then retire these RECs on behalf of RCO customers, though NAR in a sub-account established for that calendar year’s RCO RECs. These RECs will not count towards Entergy Mississippi’s Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) targets.
- **Verification Audit:** Entergy plans on using internal auditors to verify the accuracy of our RECs and Green-E RECs. EML’s internal audit has been used for several years in other Entergy Operating Companies.
- **Marketing Compliance Review (MCR):** Entergy Mississippi will be participating in the annual MCR where the Center for Resource Solutions (CRS) staff confirms that Entergy Mississippi is not making false or misleading statements about their product and that they have made pricing, power, and contract disclosure to customers in a standardized format. In addition to the MCR, Entergy Mississippi is submitting the program marketing materials to CRS to review which was launched in May of 2023.

Stakeholders will be notified by email of a 21-day comment period. Stakeholders include utilities, regulators, renewable energy advocates, and consumer and environmental protection interests who support the creation of green pricing programs by utilities in the relevant state(s). Any interested stakeholder is welcome to comment, and Green-e® Energy will encourage stakeholders to circulate the information to any other interested parties for comment. These submitted application materials will also be posted on the Green-e® website. During and after the stakeholder comment period, you will be given the opportunity to respond to any stakeholder comments.

Certification will be subject to the approval of the Green-e® Governance Board. After the 21-day stakeholder comment period, Green-e® Energy staff will forward your application materials, any stakeholder comments and your responses to those comments (if any) to the Green-e® Governance Board. The Green-e® Governance Board will have ten days to reply. If no Board comments are received during that time, the item is deemed approved. If issues are raised by the Board during that time, this may trigger a separate meeting to resolve them.

Will my rates change over time?	The subscription charges are fixed and approved by the Mississippi Public Service Commission (MPSC). Any changes to the rate would require approval through the MPSC.

What are the enrollment options?	The minimum subscription amount is 1 kW and Customers may subscribe only in increments of 1 kW up to a maximum of 5,000 kW.
What other fees might I be charged?	There are no additional fees associated with RCO. Customers must pay all applicable Entergy Mississippi rate and rider schedules, federal, state, and local taxes and charges.
How will I be billed?	RCO will be billed as a separate line item on the customer's monthly Entergy Mississippi billing statement in addition to all applicable rate and rider schedules.
Can I cancel my participation?	Yes. Participation in RCO may be terminated by written notice given by not more than six months nor less than two months prior to the expiration of the original term or any anniversary thereof.
If I want to terminate this agreement/ contract, what is the early termination fee?	There is no early termination fee associated for RCO
